

BUTTER STEADY, IMPROVEMENT IN PRICES LOOMS

Portland (UP)—A better outlook for the tone of butter was forecast here Monday. No change in prices over the week end was reported.

Practically steady tone was shown for eggs in the local trade for the week's opening. Demand is quite good and supplies of fresh are moving out as quickly as received.

There continues an acute shortage of live chickens in the local trade with practically all the leading interests now offering late advanced prices. The shortage applies to practically all chickens.

Good demand is showing for dressed turkeys here with continued light arrivals reported by practically all wholesalers. Prices are steady to firm with no general change for the day.

General lack of attention is shown for onions both at primary and jobbing points. While there has been a slight increase in the local sales since the cold weather started, the movement is still much restricted and of hand-to-mouth character.

Extreme scarcity of household tomatoes is being reported. As there is also shortage of good outdoor stuff from the south, the trade here is unable to fill orders. Household canners also scarce and firmly priced. First carload of California cauliflower of the season was reported in for the day. Quality was reported favorable and the supply was priced around \$1.80 crate for best.

While there is particularly a shortage in the market of all root vegetables are in small supply and excellent call at this time. Parsnips have advanced to 46 cents, a near-record here.

Scarcity of spinach slightly relieved by another carload from Santa Maria. Cranberry sales are better since the price was cut. All citrus prices unchanged.

Cabbage market is firm and in spots higher. California Brussels sprouts scarce and higher priced. Sweet potatoes are firmer for California offerings. Yams, too.

Columbia river smelt are scarce and higher. Mostly a dime.

feel the lack of restraint. And I want you not to allow the election of a "wet" congressman or legislator. Without the Volstead act or some similar enforcing statute, the eighteenth amendment to the constitution is a dead letter.

Rev. P. C. Taylor, pastor of the church in speaking on benefits of prohibition to the church told of four years ago in Chicago in prohibition days when he averred there were 7000 saloons and he and a friend made slumming trips through some of them and gathered ideas as to conditions then.

"The law has never been fully effective in stopping drinking or gambling. Many honest people think the conditions were better before prohibition than after. Only a few days ago a young man told me there was more drinking in America than ever before prohibition. A hotel keeper here told me the same thing. In 1917 two billion gallons of liquor were sold in the United States. At the same rate in 1929 two billion and a half billion gallons would have been sold. Twenty saloons to every individual in the United States. I ask you, where's your 20 saloons? There would be enough liquor to put 100 gallons in every automobile in the United States." Mr. Taylor declared that in many ways prohibition had lightened the burden of the church.

B. E. Shinn, manager of Miller's, in telling the benefits from a mercantile standpoint said they were not so important from a financial aspect as from the aspect that in thousands of homes people were able to buy things they never dreamed of buying in the old days, and that the greatest benefit had accrued to the mothers and fathers and boys and girls of the land.

"I conducted a mercantile establishment in Colorado next door to a saloon," he stated. "The cash register in the saloon rang 19 times to once in my store."

Dr. Edmund S. Forner spoke from the standpoint of a physician and surgeon outlining some of the effects of alcohol on the human system. He declared that in all the years of his practice he had never prescribed alcohol to a patient.
