

## CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION PLANNED BY COUNCIL

The distance will be six miles, and any knight is eligible to take part. The contestants will leave from St. Paul at 11:15 o'clock and a caravan of cars will follow the walkers.

Various outdoor games and races are scheduled for the day. Every county will be represented with a good number on the program, which will begin at 2 o'clock, and some good entertainers from Portland county will bring laughter to the crowd.

Professional swimmers will be on hand from Salem to protect those who wish to swim in the Willamette river.

REUNION HELD  
CAMP SANTIAM

Riverview—The eleventh annual reunion of the Holt-Ramsdell families was held at Camp Santiam with 35 present. In reality it is more of a Caldwell reunion, as nearly all present were direct descendants of Mrs. Margaret Caldwell, born in Virginia in 1836. In 1846, a widow with ten children, she started to Oregon from Missouri.

The family suffered many hardships and two children died on the way. The company ran short of provisions and the food had to be rationed, the mother often going without in order that her little ones might have enough. Some of the men hurried on to the Willamette valley for food to take back to the rest of the company. So many of the oxen died that several wagons had to be abandoned, compelling the immigrants to take tours walking and riding.

Among the Caldwell children, were twin sisters, Liona and Laurilla, who married Thomas Holt and Thomas Ramsdell in 1847. Both of these men were immigrants of 1844. It has been the Holts and Ramsdells who have sponsored these reunions but they have never held to the two families, always having the children from the rest of Mrs. Caldwell's family present if possible.

After coming to Oregon Margaret Caldwell was married to James Bates, and to this union was born one daughter, Mrs. Julia Ann Vaughn of Jefferson. No reunion seems complete without "Aunt Ann," as she is called by all of the relation. Besides Aunt Ann, there were grandchildren of Mrs. Caldwell's from four of the Caldwells, present Sunday.
