STOCK VALUES
DECLINE BASED
ON STEEL DROP

New York (AP)—A vicious setback, after an early rally had sent many stocks to new highs for the year, could not be overcome Tuesday on the stock exchange because of persistent selling in U. S. Steel based on a decline in that company's operations.

The announcement concerning steel-lowering of operations from 53 to 52 per cent—came during the profit taking and even a late rally could not bring the market up appreciably.

The majority of stocks were 1 to 2 points down Monday's close when the final score rang.

Tuesday's steel operating estimate made by Dow, Jones and Co., recorded the first decline in operations for the leading producer since the upturn at the beginning of the year.

Independent steel companies made gains, their operations being placed at 49 per cent of capacity, against \$1 per cent a week ago, and 49 per cent two weeks ago.

Early in the day the steel stocks had led the market into higher territory. Before the decline value gains ranging to 7 points were made by J. I. Case, Columbian Carbon, Vanadium and a host list of others.

Auto shares were helped near the close by reports from Detroit indicating a stepping up in operations of several automobile manufacturers.

American Smelting was firm in the copper. Oils dipped with the remainder of the market. Utilities lost ground with the exception of American Waterworks, which held part of a wide early gain.
