CROPLAN OFFICE
 OPENED IN SALEM

Ira Hyde, district representative
 of the Federal crop production loan
 office, with headquarters in Port-
 land, was in Salem today and an-
 nounced he had made arrangements
 for a permanent office here so as
 to be in Salem each Tuesday. The
 arrangements were made so that he
 will be at the offices of P. H. Bell,
 225 Oregon building, every week on
 that date to meet any farmers who
 may have problems to iron out over
 agricultural seed loans.

Mr. Hyde stated that while just
 at the present time no seed loans
 are being made a later date the
 plan is to reopen the loans for
 winter wheat. He says that
 while wheat loans are what are
 generally made as this is the de-
 mand over the country, it is likely
 loans for this territory may be
 opened up on other grains peculiar
 to this locality.

P. H. Bell also stated today he
 is now taking applications for fed-
 eral land bank loans.

STOCKS GO UP ALL ALONG LINE TO NEW LEVELS

New York, July 13 (AP)—Sensational advances in "wet" stocks, a pickup in rails, rubbers, utilities and sugars and broad advances in special issues brought the stock market to substantially higher ground today.

Volume was heavy and sales were around 7,000,000 shares for the day.

The dollar was steady, slightly lower in terms of sterling and slightly higher in terms of the French franc. Bonds were higher in active turnover, featured by rails and speculative issues notably the convertibles. Cotton held a small gain, while grains eased off with wheat closing at net losses of more than a cent a bushel.

The leaders in the industrial division made the best showing of any recent session. U. S. Steel featured, rising to a new high since 1931 at 64 1/2, up 2 points from the previous close.

A telephone made a new high for the year at 134 1/2, up 4 1/2. American can also bettered its high for the year, selling at 97 1/2, up 4 1/2 points. Youngstown Sheet and Tube, Bethlehem and Republic showed gains ranging to 2 points.

J. I. Case crossed 100 in early trading but lost part of the gain. In the grain market,
