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STANDARD OIL HEADQUARTERS TO AID PRESIDENT

Washington, July 29 (AP)—James A. Moffett, who resigned as vice president of the Standard Oil Company of New Jersey because of disagreement with other officials of the company over President Roosevelt's oil recovery policies, was understood in authoritative quarters today to be the executive's choice for petroleum administrator under the national recovery law.

His resignation culminated determined conflicts of opinion between himself and Walter C. Teagle, president of the company, and also a member of the advisory committee aiding Hugh S. Johnson, industrial administrator.

W. S. Parish, chairman of the board of the New Jersey Standard Oil, said, differed with Moffett's views. He and Teagle maintained silence today on Moffett's resignation.

Moffett himself was in New York. Those in federal and oil industry circles in a position to know asserted Moffett's resignation was accepted by the Standard board on Teagle's order because of the difference between Moffett and Teagle over the recovery program.

President Roosevelt, Secretary Ickes and Johnson asked Moffett to serve on the advisory committee aiding Johnson this week.

Teagle was reported to have told him he either would have to resign from the Standard company or reject the committee place.

Arriving at Hyde Park, N. Y., for his vacation at home, the president read with interest today accounts of Moffett's resignation. It was indicated the administration had not been satisfied with the attitude of some of the Standard Oil of New Jersey officers as to development of the recovery program.

Moffett told Teagle to accept his resignation, setting forth subsequently in a statement that he considered the request to serve on the Johnson committee as a command.

Announcing his hearty accord with President Roosevelt's policies for stabilizing the petroleum industry, Moffett added in his statement:

"My views as to the policies to be pursued apparently are not in accord with those of the board of the New Jersey company."

Chicago, July 29 (AP)—Excited efforts to get rid of speculative holdings of future delivery grain contracts whirled all the cereal markets down late today to the lowest prices permissible.

Breaks in quotations were in the face of crop news that would ordinarily have bolstered values. For the time being, however, traders lost sight of every market factor except that a huge selling flurry was in progress, and that there was need of haste if transactions were to be accomplished before emergency limits could be enforced.

This was the second day in succession that wheat lost the limit of 5 cents a bushel. The close in all the pits was demoralized at the day's bottom figures, wheat 5 cents down, and corn 4 cents, with oats off 3 cents and provisions showing 5 to 35 cents decline.

Severe downward trends in grain values here today followed sharp price setbacks in wheat quotations at Winnipeg. Selling operations in Chicago took on large proportions before adequate buying power was attracted.

Opening 2 1/4-4 1/2 cents down, wheat afterward rallied somewhat. Corn started 15-25 cents off and subsequently held near the initial range.
