

BUTTER, EGGS REMAIN FIRM ALONG COAST

Portland, Feb. 13 (AP)—Trading in the egg market is considered about steady over the semi-holiday. There was no change in conditions or price on the local market.

Butter price, unchanged. Columbia river smelt are moving into all coast states and into the Dakotas, Idaho, Montana and Utah. Selling mostly \$1.25 per 50-lb. box. Run slackened off a trifle.

Owing to the extreme quality of Yuma offerings, Arizona lettuce is selling generally 25c crate higher than the best Imperial valley.

Market for onions continues to show a firm tone at \$1.50 net in the country while re-sales to retailers here are higher and generally up to \$1.90 central for best. Onion sets also firmer.

Celery market is booming in the south which is forcing extreme prices here. Another carload of Florida new potatoes due Friday and also a carload of California peas.

Hothouse cucumbers are a trifle more plentiful and selling around \$1.40-50 dozen for local choice. Ripe bananas are again being generally offered.

its discretion" license hotels and restaurants and any other place of business they may see fit. "In counties of 100,000 or more population" to sell any and all alcoholic liquors by the glass for consumption on the premises.

As a sop to such of the upstate counties they may desire to let down the bars to the return of the season, or semi-saloons, a further amendment is proposed to permit the liquor commission to grant such licenses in smaller counties at the request of the county court, thereby paying the way to perpetual lobbying by the liquor interests not only of the state commission but the individual county courts.

To ease the opposition of upstate hotelmen and others who objected to the suggested scale of fees for by-the-glass licenses, a further amendment was proposed to permit the commission to fix license fees at anywhere from \$250 to \$1000, with the understanding that the ambitious Portland licensees would be willing to pay the maximum license and will offer no objections if the commission sees fit to fix lower fees for upstate hotels.

There is no longer any attempt to camouflage the issue involved. The hotelmen and the restaurant owners, who are represented in the lobby by a paid attorney, confess that they are principally concerned with securing the profits they foresee in legalization of the sale of hard liquor by the glass.

They freely confess that they are seeking to attract back to the established hotels and restaurants the business which has been going of late to beer gardens and road houses and which have been running with practically no restraint.

In this they are inviting direct conflict with the indicated policies of the newly appointed liquor commission, which has announced its intention of shutting down tight upon the rural beer joints that have drawn down so much criticism on the operation of the Knox law.

The new commission made it entirely clear before the house committee on alcoholic affairs that with the cooperation of the state police they propose to deal drastically with beer dispensaries which invoke complaints through revocation of licenses.

Lined up behind the proposed cocktail bill are the Portland hotel operators, the Portland restaurant owners and a scattering of "speakeasy" operators who have visions of legalizing their business and escaping heavy "incidental" costs of operation to which they are now subjected.

Giving silent support to the cocktail scheme are the former organized forces of prohibition, who force in unrestrained abuse of the liquor control system the best chance for a return to prohibition. The fight to bring the "cocktail" bill out of committee is led by Rep. Howard Latourette, joined with him are Representatives Caulfield, Edwin and Frazer.

Opposing the change and standing pat for retention of the present restrictions of the liquor control act, according to an unofficial canvass of the committee, are Representatives Hill, Fuhrer, Fatland, Honeyman and Gouley.
