

PLAN TO EAT OUTDOORS OFTEN

Plant to eat outdoors often. This usually appeals to all the family and makes the serving simple. Serve one hot dish that will stay hot for a little while.

DINNER SERVING FOUR
Sliced Corned Beef
Escalloped Succotash
Bread and Butter Sandwiches
Cherry Butter Salad Bowl
Caramel Dessert
Milk for Children

ESCALLOPED SUCCOTASH
1 1/2 cups cooked lima beans
2 cups cooked corn
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon paprika
1/2 teaspoon sugar
1/2 cup butter
2 tablespoons flour

Mix flour with butter, add milk and cook until sauce thickens slightly. Add rest of ingredients. Pour into buttered baking dish and bake 20 minutes in moderate oven. Serve in dish in which baked.

CHERRY BUTTER
8 cups seeded red cherries
2 cups sliced pineapple
2 tablespoons lemon juice
8 cups sugar
Mix ingredients and boil 5 minutes. Lower fire and simmer until butter thickens. This will require about 30 minutes. Pour into glasses and chill. Seal with paraffin.

SALAD BOWL
Crisp cabbage leaves
1 cup sliced cucumbers
1 cup sliced radishes
1 cup chopped onions
1 cup chopped green peppers
1/2 cup sliced tomatoes
1/2 cup sliced paprika
1/2 cup salad dressing
Line bowl with cabbage leaves. Add rest of ingredients combined.

CARAMEL DESSERT
1 cup dark brown sugar
1/2 cup flour
2 egg yolks
2 cups milk
1 teaspoon vanilla
1/2 teaspoon almond extract
2 egg whites, beaten
Blend sugar with flour and salt. Add yolks and milk. Cook in double boiler until dessert thickens, stirring constantly. Add extracts and fold in whites. Cool and chill. Serve plain or with cream.

Dessert Party

Informal summer entertaining is in vogue and the "dessert parties" for both afternoon and evening are proving popular. Have the guests come right after their meal and eat dessert with the party. The desserts can be plain or fancy. One hostess serves several to suit the various tastes of her guests.

FRUIT PLATTER
2 cantaloupes
2 cups berries (any kind)
2 cups sliced peaches
2 cups cherries
2 cups whipped cream
2 cups cream
2 cups confectioner's sugar
Cut cantaloupes in halves, arrange portions of berries, peaches and cherries separately in glass cups or bowls. Arrange cantaloupes and fruits on large platter in the center of which are bowls of cream and sugar. Garnish with greenery. The guests may help themselves.

STRAWBERRY ICE CREAM
(Other berries can be used)
3 quarts thin cream
4 cups sugar
2 tablespoons vanilla
4 cups crushed berries
Add 1/2 the sugar to the berries and chill 2 hours or longer. Add rest of sugar to cream, add vanilla and pour into sterilized freezer. When half frozen add berries and freeze until stiff. Remove dasher, pack cream to "ripen" for 2 hours or longer. Peaches are delicious used in place of the berries.

YELLOW CAKE
1 cup butter
1 cup sugar
2 eggs
1 cup orange juice (strained)
1/2 cup lemon juice
1/2 cup flour
1/2 cup baking powder
Cream butter and sugar. Add rest of ingredients and beat 3 minutes. Bake 20 minutes in 2 layer cake pans lined with waxed paper in a moderate oven. Cool and ice with any white frosting.

In the Freezer
GRAPE SHERBET
(Can be used in Mechanical Refrigerator)
1/2 cup sugar
1 cup water
1 1/2 cups grape juice
Boil sugar and water 1 minute. Cool and add rest of ingredients, pour into tray in mechanical refrigerator and freeze four hours. Stir twice at 30-minute intervals.

This sherbet can be frozen by regular freezer method. Grape sherbet is very good served with the main course for luncheon or dinner.

PEACH SHERBET FOR 8
2 cups sugar
2 cups water
2 cups crushed peaches
2 egg whites, beaten
2 teaspoons vanilla
Boil sugar and water 2 minutes. Cool and add lemon juice and peaches. Pour into freezer and when half frozen, add rest of ingredients and freeze until stiff.

Tomato juice brings Vitamin A, which helps build resistance to infection, and because of the proportions of natural sugars and acids, makes a refreshing drink.

If you are accustomed to serving tomato juice with canapés when you entertain, you will wish to jot down some of the following combinations which make delicious spreads:

Liverwurst mashed to a paste, seasoned with chili sauce.
Cream cheese mixed with minced onion.
Chicken or tuna fish blended with mayonnaise.
Chopped olives blended with mayonnaise.
Deviled ham or deviled tongue.
Chopped eggs seasoned with mustard and chili sauce.
Peanut butter with lemon juice.
Peanut butter with chopped pickle.
Peanut butter, chopped bacon, and lemon juice.

Following is a list of suggested garnishments for your canapés:
Finely chopped hard-boiled egg white.
Tiny pearl onions.
Slices of tomato, radish or pickle.
Halves of salted almonds or peanuts.
Maraschino cherry circles.

A new field of savories may be obtained when serving tomato juice by preparing either of the seasoned appetizers listed below.

Tomato and Orange Cocktail
3 cups tomato juice
1/2 cup orange juice
1/2 cup lemon juice
1/2 cup sugar
2 teaspoons chopped onion
A little salt, pepper and paprika
Combine the ingredients, mix thoroughly and let stand in refrigerator for at least one hour. Then strain through colander and pour over crushed ice in cocktail glasses.

Appetizer Cocktail
1 onion, finely chopped
1/2 cup tomato juice
Lemon juice to taste
Add one onion, finely chopped, to the tomato juice, chill thoroughly, strain through a colander, add lemon juice to taste just before serving.

HOW TO KEEP GAS BILL DOWN

Here are a few simple tips which will help homemakers minimize their gas bills.

Always use double or triple pans, when possible.
It is more economical to use a small unit than a large unit and to use the burner which is already hot. When they want hot water, of heating a gallon when a quart would be sufficient.

Always try to cook by the thermometer, both to save heat and to avoid burning food, and open the oven only to put in and take out food. Needless opening of the oven can be avoided by using a time and temperature chart.

1 pkg. orange flavored gelatin mixture
1 1/2 cups boiling water
4 tablespoons sugar
1 teaspoon lemon juice
1 1/2 cups raspberries
1 cup whipped cream
Pour water over gelatin mixture, add sugar and mix thoroughly. Chill until slightly firm, beat until frothy and fold in rest of ingredients. Chill until firm. Serve plain or with cream. Other berries or fruits can replace the raspberries.
