**JOIN GERMANY IN PROTECTION OF NATIONALS**  
 (Continued from page 1)

Paris, Aug. 21 (AP)—A report that the German ambassador to Moscow had made a "threatening" protest to Russian foreign commissar Maxim Litvinoff against alleged Soviet interference in the Spanish civil war, was circulated tonight in Paris diplomatic circles.

(From Berlin it was announced the German government had protested to Moscow against allegedly unfair radio broadcasts, but the nature of the protest was not stated. A second protest was sent from Berlin to Madrid, following yesterday's stern warning concerning the reported search of a German steamship by a loyalist war vessel.)

A foreign office spokesman said they were "unable to confirm or deny" the diplomatic report concerning the "threatening" nature of the protest.

## Two in Hospital by Accidental Shooting

Ontario, Aug. 21 (AP)—Martin Kane, sheepman, and 15-year-old Warren Atherton, both of Ontario, are in a hospital here with groin wounds sustained when each was accidentally shot.

Kane struck the hammer of his rifle in pulling an ax from his kit while camped on Bear creek divide, 120 miles northeast of here. A sheepherder traveled 15 miles to a telephone and with the aid of a forest ranger and three CCC men carried him out of the hills.

Atherton was shot by a hunting companion, in an "empty gun" accident.

Both are believed to have a good chance of recovery.

## PROWLER BEATS RUBY LORAIN

Hollywood, Aug. 21 (AP)—Ruby Loraine, English film comedienne, and wife of Novelist Rupert Grayson, was taken to a private hospital today for medical treatment of injuries suffered when she was beaten in her home by an armed prowler.

The actress was attacked in the kitchen of her Beverly Hills home shortly before midnight and during a struggle her assailant attempted to shoot her.

Miss Loraine grasped the man's arm just before he pulled the trigger, and the bullet hit the kitchen ceiling.

The prowler fled when neighbors who heard the actress scream came rushing towards the house. The only clue he left behind was a white handkerchief-mask which Miss Loraine tore from his face during her battle with him.

The actress was taken to Hollywood receiving hospital for emergency treatment and then went to a private hospital. She suffered three egg-sized bumps on her head and received a long gash on the right side of her jaw.

## Bids Rejected for Coos Bay Project

Portland, Aug. 21 (AP)—Colonel Thomas M. Robbins, United States division engineer, has rejected both bids submitted for the dredging of the Coos Bay ship channel.

The Tacoma Dredging company asked \$193,521 and the Puget Sound Bridge and Dredging company \$207,675.

Colonel Robbins based his action on the fact that the low bid was more than 25 per cent over the estimate of the U. S. engineering corps.

The job will be readvertised immediately, Colonel Robbins said the engineering corps will do the work if the bids are still too high.

## Longest Aqueduct Has Its First Flow

Ontario, Aug. 21 (AP)—The longest large aqueduct yet built by the U. S. bureau of reclamation had its first flow of water yesterday.

It is the 4 1/2 mile siphon in the Dead Ox flat section of the Owyhee project, which cost \$708,000 and is six feet, seven inches in diameter.

Water will continue to flow through it for the remainder of the season to puddle the banks of the big canal across the northern portion of the project which will be farmed next year.
