

DANCY ESTATE PUT IN PROBATE

The estate of W. H. Dancy, valued at \$20,000, has been admitted to probate with Jessie Creighton Jones, a sister-in-law, named as executrix. Of the property \$10,000 is in realty and \$10,000 is personal property. The home at 369 N. Liberty street is to be sold and the proceeds divided one-fourth each to two sisters-in-law, Jessie C. Jones and Mabel S. Creighton and the other half to a sister, Mrs. Adelaide M. Eberlin. Common stock in the Columbia River Paper company is left to Salem General hospital which is directed to establish a memorial for Mollie C. Dancy, his wife, who predeceased him. The hospital also is made residuary legatee of the estate.

Cash in Ladd and Bush bank is divided one-half to Mrs. Eberlin and a fourth each to Jessie C. Jones and Mabel S. Creighton. Cash in the United States National bank is divided between Mrs. Jones and Miss Creighton, the same disposition being made of hay and produce from the Wallowa ranch.

Specific bequests also include the following: 25 shares of Incorporated Investors stock and 10 shares of Columbia River paper stock to Laura Eberlin, a niece; 13 shares of American Telephone & Telegraph stock to Adelaide Eberlin; 11 shares of the same stock to Mrs. Jones and Miss Creighton; six shares of Incorporated Investors to the YWCA; 26 shares of the same stock to Rosalie Porter, a niece; the automobile and a ring and diamond stick pin to Creighton Benton Jones, nephew; and a gold watch and chain to George Alvin Porter.

TUNNEL WORK BEGUN BY WPA

A crew of WPA men, employed by the Salem water commission, yesterday began the digging of the 500-foot tunnel that is to pierce the hump on Rural avenue approaching the Fairmount reservoir. It will be a 24-hour three-shift job, only five men working on each shift on account of cramped space in which to work.

The tunnel will range from 19 to 25 feet underground, and as the work progresses it will be timbered to assure safety for the workers. They will be equipped with carbide

miners' lamps for illumination in the dark hole. Much of the formation to be removed will be rock. It is believed about two months will be necessary to complete the job. Department officials said tunneling instead of trenching for the laying of the 27-inch steel pipe would be the more economical process.
