

SIMONDS SAYS HE PREFERS TO DESTROY PLANT

Philadelphia, Aug. 21 (AP)—A. T. Simonds, president of the strike-bound Abrasive company, said yesterday that he would tear the plant down brick by brick and spend the rest of his life fishing, before he gave in to the committee for industrial organization.
