

### Fox to Talk On Prophecy

Beginning Sunday night, January 16, at the First Baptist church, the pastor, Dr. Irving A. Fox, will begin his series on "Dispensational Truth," illustrated by a large prophetic chart.

February 13—"Dispensation of the Chosen Nation, or the Age of the Law." Why the law was given. Sabbath for Israel only. Key of the promises. Israel's present state and future glory.

February 20—"The Dispensation of the Bible and Science." Illustrated by \$10,000 worth of electrical equipment.

February 27—"Dispensation of the Messiah, or the Age of the Fullness of Time." Son of David. God, the Son. Selected king. Lamb of God.

March 6—"Dispensation of the Church and the Holy Ghost." Temple. Household. Chaste virgin. Bride. Unconditional grace. Secret call of the Spirit. Secret coming of the Bridegroom.

March 13—"The 70th Week of Daniel, or the Story of the Antichrist." The day of Jacob's trouble and the end of the times of the Gentiles.

March 20—"Dispensation of the King." Marriage of the lamb. Appearance in glory. Rebuilding Jerusalem. All Israel saved. One thousand years of glory.

March 27—"Dispensation After the Thousand Years." White throne. Second resurrection. Second death. New heavens and new earth. The endless increase.

April 3—"The Four Judgments of the Scriptures."

April 10—"The Significance of the Days of Scripture." The numerical structure of the Bible.
