Parking Meter Offers Show Much Variety

Parking meters, if and when they are adopted by the city of Salem, will cost somewhere between \$25.95 and \$65 each, and the terms of purchase will be as liberal as could be expected. And it will be found, that while parking meters are a comparatively new method of collecting public money, they are made in a variety of ways by half a dozen or more manufacturing concerns. At the city council meeting Monday night proposals—no bids—were received from six companies. They had been invited by resolution of the council. But, while the council has authorized itself by another resolution to install parking meters, it is not yet certain that they will be set up in this town, for there is strong opposition from rather formidable quarters. So the proposals were merely referred to the special traffic committee for study.

Here are the proposals: From the Pacific Parking Meter Corporation of San Francisco—This company offers a meter manufactured by M. H. Rhodes, Inc. and its trade name is "Mark-Time." The least expensive of seven models offered is \$25.95 per meter, and the most expensive \$55. The company offers to give the city a trial of not less than six months. During this time the meter ordinances must be enforced strictly, and the city make regular collections from the meters, depositing the money in a special bank account or in escrow. Out of the collections 25 per cent would be paid to the city and 75 per cent to M. H. Rhodes, Inc. At the conclusion of the six months the city would have the following options: (a) To request the removal of the meters and posts, and restoration of sidewalks to a satisfactory condition. This would be done, under bond if required, by the Pacific Parking Meter corporation, at no expense to the city. When the city had ordered removal of the meters their entire obligation would cease, and such sums as had been paid to the city during the trial period would be retained by the city. (b) To continue the metered parking system, and to continue the division of collections as above outlined until the full sums due for each meter had been made to M. H. Rhodes, Inc., the sums paid during the trial period to be credited to the city's account. (c) To continue the metered parking system and to purchase the Mark-Time meters outright for cash, at a discount of 10 per cent on the then unpaid balance within 30 days from the conclusion of the trial period, the sums already paid to be credited to the city.

If the city desired to install the meters with its own employees under company supervision \$1.50 would be deducted from the purchase price of each meter. If the company installed them it would use a local contractor acceptable to the city. The company would furnish an installation superintendent and train a man to service the meters. It would pay the salary of the service man for six months from date of installation. If the city desired to maintain the meters with one of its employees trained by the company the company would allow a deduction of \$1.50 per meter from quoted price. The meters would be delivered and installation begun within 30 days from date of order. Used in Portland. From Graybar Electric company, Portland, a New York corporation—The meter has the trade name of "Karpark." One model, of which \$19 are in use in Portland, is offered for \$46 each or \$47.50 if equipped with counter. An automatic model is offered at \$58 or \$57.50 with counter. A six months trial period is offered. The company would furnish a service engineer during the installation period, and for a period thereafter of one month for each 100 meters purchased. They would be guaranteed for a year. The company offers to supply without charge two complete parking meters and three mechanism units with each 10 meters installed. The meters would be installed without any down payment. The city would pay to the company monthly 75 per cent of the gross receipts until paid for. If the meters were ordered out by the city at the end of six months they would be removed by the company without expense to the city. The company would pay freight and transportation charges.
