

Presbytery of Willamette in Busy Session

Albany, Sept. 21.—The Presbytery of Willamette in its fall session in the First Presbyterian church Tuesday and Wednesday approved the August conference for young people held at the government's recreational area at Silver Creek Falls park. The week's assembly was conducted by the Rev. W. Irwin Williams, pastor of the Salem Presbyterian church, and a corps of 10 teachers and helpers. Mr. Williams reported Tuesday night and showed moving pictures of class work. Seventy-five were enrolled. The conference, it is expected will be adopted by the denomination's board of Christian education for next year as one of its 75 standard conferences.

The mission of Dr. W. P. White, United Presbyterian minister formerly pastor of the U. P. church in Albany for 20 years and later with Moody Bible Institute, was endorsed by the Presbytery. He has been conducting a mission to unchurched homes of southern Lincoln county, working with Presbyterian pastors and churches in Waldport and Newport. He is to visit the homes in Benton county outside of the organized parishes. The First Baptist church of Corvallis, Dr. E. C. Hart, pastor, is sponsoring his work.

The National Missions committee reported changes in only a few mission fields in the Presbytery and made appropriations for the work. Dr. James Thomson of Seattle, national missions superintendent for the northwest, spoke.

New ministers in Presbytery include the Rev. W. B. Mahan coming to Independence from Portland Northminster and to be installed as pastor Friday evening. The Rev. James Asa Smith, Presbytery's Stated Clerk, will preside; Dr. D. J. Ferguson of Albany will preach the installation sermon; Dr. E. W. Warrington of the State college faculty will charge the minister and the Rev. Oscar Payne of Salem will charge the people. A congregational dinner will precede the installation service at Independence.

The Rev. E. F. McFarland, coming from the Presbytery of southwest Oregon, who led the opening devotions of Presbytery, was placed in charge of the Cottage Grove church.

Thursday morning the devotional service was conducted by the Rev. Walter Duff of Dallas. Dr. Norman K. Tully of Eugene reported for the

foreign missions committee, setting up a two weeks' itinerary among the churches in November for a missionary party commissioned by the foreign board. Educational matters were presented by the Rev. Robert H. Prentice of Bend and bills and overtures by Dr. A. M. Williams of Nelscott. The Rev. Dr. Ferguson of Albany led a conference on "Modern Isms vs. Presbyterianism."

Bishop Remington And Wife Injured

Pendleton, Ore., Sept. 21 (AP)—Rev. and Mrs. William P. Remington of the Eastern Oregon Episcopal diocese were injured, but not dangerously, in an automobile accident last night on the highway three miles north of Adams.

The bishop suffered a broken finger and cut on the arm and Mrs. Remington, a cut on the forehead.

The bishop said he saw a white horse on the road and slowed up, fortunately, as he did not see a darker one behind it and could not avoid hitting the second animal. He was able to keep the car right side up.

Crockett Killed On Oregon City

Oregon City, Sept. 21 (AP)—James T. Crockett, 86, was struck and killed at 2:30 p.m. Wednesday by an oil truck driven by Lee Sellers of Portland on the super highway at the north city limits of Oregon City.

The truck overturned, spilled gasoline over the highway, and knocked down the pumps of a service station. Sellers, however, was not hurt. Police said Crockett was hit when he started to run across the highway. Sellers was not held.

An inspection of the home of the hosts will commence at 1:30 o'clock and will precede a general meeting in the auditorium. Capt. Cicero F. Hogan of Portland, rehabilitation officer of the national organization of Disabled American Veterans of the World war, will address the meeting regarding the present program of rehabilitation and the rules and laws affecting the disabled man and his dependents. Huntley of Eugene, state commander of the DAV in Oregon, will present talk on the hospital work of the organization, and its purpose. As manager of the Roseburg hospital, Col. Tandy will give first hand information on the care and treatment of the disabled man in order to clearly present to the visitors a picture that they may take back to their individual groups.

Chapters of the Disabled American Veterans of the World War, who will comprise the caravan of cars with their civilian guests, will represent Forest Grove, Portland, Salem, Grants Pass, Bend, Eugene, McMinnville, Oregon City and Klamath Falls.

Local Commander Ted C. Perenboom invites the public, especially representatives of lodges and civic groups, to attend.
