

Parliament of France to Vote Its Own Death

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French capital, which outlined exact procedure to be followed the French and the kinds of government which will be set up.

The German dispatches said French chamber and senate would not have the quorum required by French constitution for a legal meeting but added that neither would "insist" on the constitutional form.

The new constitution, the Germans said, will abandon the traditional French slogan of "liberty, equality and fraternity" and substitute "labor, family and the fatherland" and open the way for French collaboration in a "new order in Europe."

The parliament will meet and Vice-Premier Pierre Laval, friend of Italy, present a brief resolution which must be accepted by senators and deputies without opposition. This resolution puts an end to the life of the parliamentary chamber and places in the hands of the

The chamber will signify its approval by a standing vote. The session will last only an hour or 20 minutes.
