Baar told the committee the HOP chambers, which he said includ-ed 25 state and two regional organizations, believed that bus-PICKERS iness "cannot possibly produce the additional revenue requested by the treasury and sur-vive." WANTED

For this reason he said his organization favored a retail sales tax. He asked also for technical changes in the methods of determining excess pro-fits, for repeal of the capital stock tax and for a 20 per cent tax allowance for individuals and corporations for the chase of non-interest bearing government bonds.

While urging a sales tax as had the U. S. Chamber of Commerce, the NAM said a 5 per cent withholding tax on individual earnings, such as the chamber also proposed, was "impractical and indefensible."
