## Counties Ask Forest Funds

Portland, Nov. 21 (AP)—The Association of Oregon Counties asked the federal government again yesterday for a 2 per cent payment on federal forest land in the state.

The money would be paid in lieu of taxes, the association said, voting to continue its public lands committee, which is promoting a congressional bill authorizing the payment.

The association voted down a proposal to use brass from the old battleship Oregon, about to be scrapped for its metal, for plaques for the counties.

Also opposed was any plan to change the state motor vehicle laws. The association said they are "flexible enough."

Other resolutions favored changes in the welfare laws, including: conformity with other states on welfare requirement; increased contributions to the social security program; relief payments to minors of \$25 for infants up to five years old and \$20 from 5 to 21 years, with counties contributing \$5 for each child committed by a court.

## Marines Looking for More Islands to Seize

Pearl Harbor, T. H., Nov. 21 (AP)—The United States marines on Guadalcanal, cheered by the navy's great triumph over the Japanese fleet last week-end, are looking for more islands to

conquer. Lieut. DeWitt Peterkin, first American naval officer to arrive here from the Solomons since the navy's victory Nov. 14-15, said he believed some 10,000 Japanese have been killed on Guadalcanal.

"The marines and other forces felt better after last week-end's big naval battle than any time since I was there," said Peterkin, of New York, an assistant to the J. P. Morgan partner before he entered the service.

"They feel that they have been through everything, and have taken everything the Japs could give. They're optimistic and already are talking about the next move westward."
