

Frau Himmler Still Proud Of Her Infamous Husband

Internment Camp on Rome's outskirts, July 13 (AP)—Frau Margarete Himmler maintained today that she was still proud of her infamous husband and shrugged away the world's hatred of the dead Gestapo chief with the calm observation that no one loves a policeman. When 1 told her that husband Heinrich had been captured and had died from his own dose of poison Frau Himmler showed absolutely no emotion. She sat, hands folded in her lap, and merely shrugged her shoulders.

Until then she had not known what had happened to Himmler since he last telephoned her from Berlin around Easter while she was at their home near Munich.

When first captured by the Fifth army she had claimed a weak heart and internment camp officials, fearful of a heart attack, never told her of her husband's death.

But even when I told her that Himmler was buried in an unmarked grave Frau Himmler showed no surprise, no interest. It was the coldest exhibition of complete control of human feeling that I have ever witnessed.

I talked to Frau Himmler in a luxurious villa home owned by a former movie magnate where she and her 15-year-old daughter, Gudrun, are being held here with one other female internee.

I asked her if she was aware of her husband's activities as Gestapo chief and she replied, "Of course."

Then I asked if she knew what the world had thought of him and she replied, "I know that before the war many people thought highly of him."

Asked if she realized that Himmler was probably the most despised and hated man in the world after the European war got well under way, Frau Margarete shrugged and said, "Maybe so. He was a policeman and policemen are not liked by anyone."

Frau Margarete denied the possibility that her dead husband might have been considered the No. 1 war criminal. She said, "My husband? How could he be when Hitler was fuhrer?"

Men Over 26 Can Switch Jobs

Washington, July 13 (AP)—Men 26 or over who do not meet the army's regular physical standards are free today to change jobs without draft board permission.

At the request of the army, selective service last night relaxed its regulations to exclude these men from the possibility of induction as job-jumpers.

Heretofore these registrants who switched employment without approval of their board could be drafted for limited army service. The job-jumper penalties, invoked six months ago to nip a trend away from war work, remain in effect for all physically fit men, as well as for registrants under 26 who fall shy of regular requirements.

Men in the latter group who fail to clear job changes will continue to be inducted under relaxed physical standards.

Older men freed of clearance responsibility are those classified in 4-F, 2-A (F), 2-A (L), 2-B (F) and 2-B (L).

All of these are classes for men who do not meet regular physical standards.

Goodenough to Be Sent East

The legislative interim committee to study revision of Oregon laws announced today it will send Bryan Goodenough, state code commissioner, to Kentucky and Wisconsin to study the code systems of those states.

Goodenough, who will leave Sunday and be gone several weeks, also might visit other states. He said Kentucky and Wisconsin are recognized as having the best code system in the nation.

Oregon's code has not been revised since it was compiled in 1862. The interim committee will report to the 1947 legislature, and will recommend elimination of many laws and a new compilation of others.

Members of the committee are Sen. Irving Rand, Portland, chairman; Sen. Paul Patterson, Hillsboro; and Reps. Carl Francis, Dayton; Robert H. Bennett, Portland; and W. W. Baldersee, Grants Pass.

OWI Wins in Fight for Funds

Washington, July 13 (AP)—Congress dispatched a \$768,364,850 war agencies appropriation bill to the White House today after six weeks of controversy revolving about funds for OWI and FEPC. Legislative action was completed when the senate approved a compromise fixing the amount for the office of war information at \$35,000,000.

The house had approved it earlier after a futile effort, spearheaded by republicans, to scale it down. The house accepted a house stipulation that no funds of the war labor board should be expended in connection with disputes involving agricultural workers.

OWI's appropriation was one of 33 items in disagreement between the senate and the house in a \$768,364,850 war agencies supply bill that had been deadlocked more than a month over funds for the fair employment practice committee. The FEPC fight was settled yesterday with both branches voting it \$250,000, less than half its budget estimate.

Still in controversy in the house before the compromise goes to the senate for final approval is a house-voted and senate-rejected provision excluding agricultural workers from jurisdiction of the war labor board.
