Hollywood, Sept. 19 (AP)—Shirley Temple, on her second film career at the age of 17, becomes a post-war bride tonight when she marries army air forces Sgt. John George Agar, Jr., 24.

"I wanted to be his wife before he is sent across," said the future Mrs. Agar.

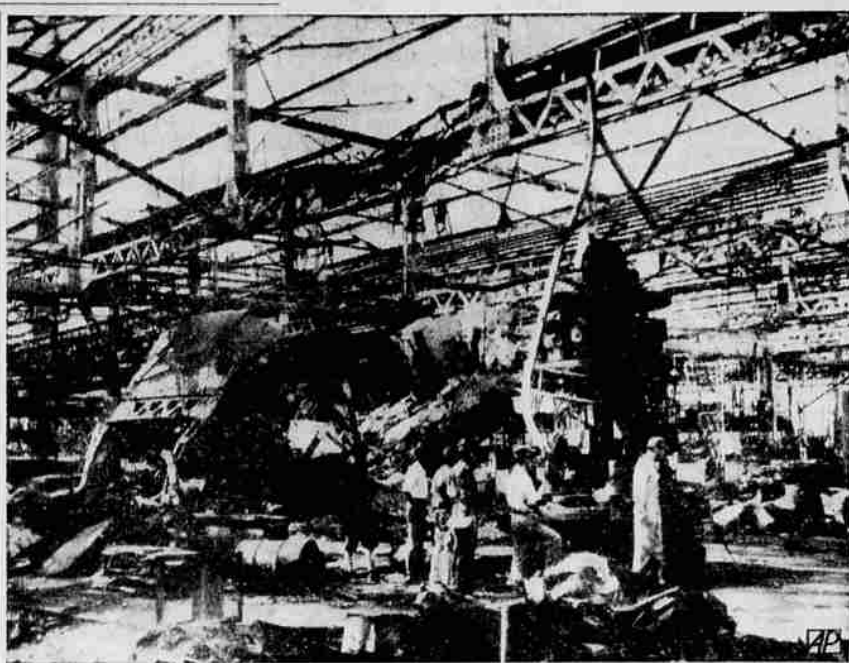
The Beverly Hills, Calif., sergeant has only a seven-day furlough before he is due back at his Spokane, Wash., base for overseas duty. Agar met the former child star, now playing glamour roles, two years ago at a swimming party.

There will be few motion picture celebrities at the Wilshire Methodist church when Rev. Willis Martin performs the ceremony at 8:30 p.m. But prop men, wardrobe girls and electricians will mingle with Shirley's socially select schoolmates from the Westlake school for girls.

When they first announced their engagement, Miss Temple and Agar promised their parents they would wait "at least two years," but the redeployment assignment changed their minds.

Shirley's brother, Jack, and his wife will be best man and matron of honor at the wedding. Bridesmaids are school friends of Miss Temple's—Katherine Ferguson, Phoebe Hearst, Mary Lou Isleib, Betty Jean Lail, Nancy Majors and Constance Webb.

Japanese Gold Will Be Seized

Los Angeles, Sept. 19 (AP)—Japanese gold totaling an estimated 300 million to two billion dollars will be seized under a reparations policy that will be "tough on Japan," Edwin W. Pauley, American member of the allied reparations commission, said here Tuesday.

Pauley, 43, member and former treasurer of the democratic national committee, told a news conference he will leave within 30 days for Japan, accompanied by the secretary of the navy and a war department representative, to formulate reparations policies.

Of Japanese gold, Pauley said: "Naturally we do not propose to leave that with the emperor, although it will be only a drop in the bucket compared with our total expenses in waging the war, not to mention losses in allied lives.

"The gold is one of the things we can take. We're not interest-
