Sugar—Book 4: 1 through 21 through Dec. 31. Shoes—Book 3: Airplane stamps 1-3-3-4 now valid. Tires—Use mileage rationing record in making applications. Price Control—Pay no more than ceiling prices to help prevent inflation. Rent Control—In Federal rent control areas all rented dwellings must be reclassified.
