An official Tass news agency dispatch reported the Byrnes' peace conference speech ver-batim. It made no comment on the speech. Tass also distribut-ed the text of Molotov's reply, in which the Soviet foreign minister accepted Byrnes chal-lenge to publish the American's speech in the Russian press.


