

Nicotine Dusts Control Aphids

Nicotine dusts are still the standard recommendation for control of hop aphids though several of the newer chemical dusts have given promising results for use when nicotine is not readily available, according to a report on hop aphid research just issued by the O. S. C. Experiment station.

The recent scarcity of nicotine sulphate has created an acute problem among Oregon hop growers, according to a report contained in station circular of information No. 393. This material has the advantage of killing the insects both by contact and by the fumes it gives off.

The newer insecticides tried in experiments over the past few years are purely contact killers, hence they have to be applied more thoroughly to the under side of the leaves. Most of the machines now used by growers for dusting are not suitable for applying the purely contact dusts, it was found. The war-born aerosol generators have shown promising results with some of the new materials but not with others.

Authors of the circular are H. E. Morrison, Dr. Don C. Mole and W. B. Rasmussen, all of the entomology department of the station.

Washington, Nov. 21 (AP)—William F. Buchanan and A. Stolen, partners in the lumber supply company of Tacoma, Wash., have been barred by the civilian production administration from placing certified orders for housing construction lumber during the next four months.

Any construction lumber received during that time must be set aside and sold only to veteran housing priority holders, the CPA ordered.

CPA said the firm had placed orders for lumber during March, April, May and June in excess of authorized amounts.

The watermelon has been reduced to a size commensurate with present-day apartment refrigerators running about 3 lbs., or the size of a cantaloupe.

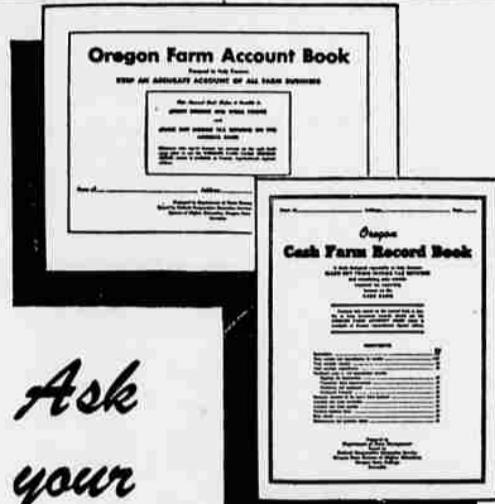
OPA-Johnson Suit Dismissed by Court

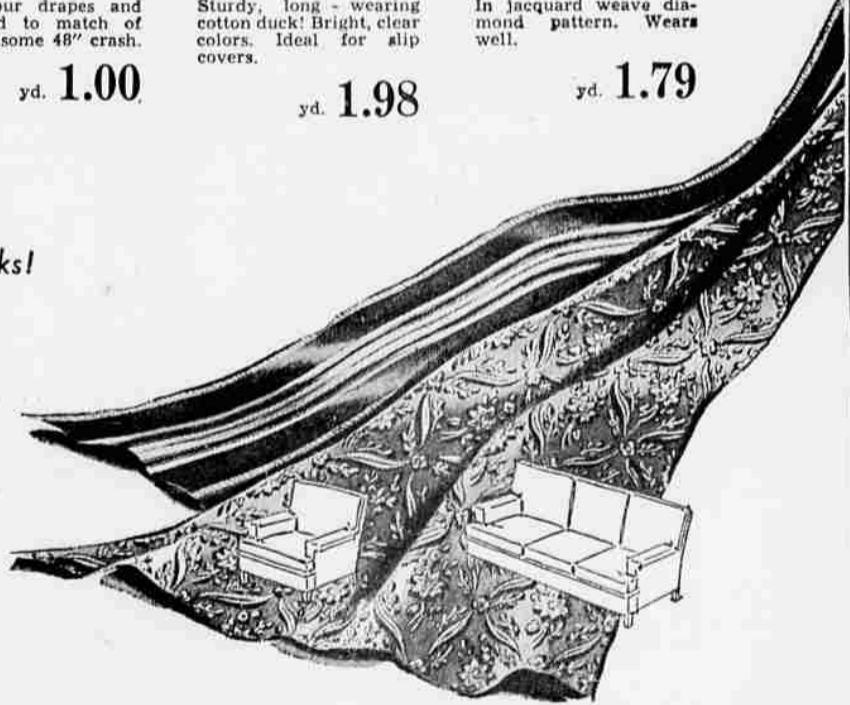
