

Dallas Water Main Ordered

Dallas—A new six-inch cast iron water main to be laid down Church street by the Dallas water commission will not only provide better service for water users but will furnish better fire protection for the business district, according to E. L. McCleary, manager.

The line will be just a block off Main street and parallel to Main. Four new and modern fire hydrants will be installed and will be within easy reach of all downtown buildings in case of fire. Being a block off the street they will afford better protection than hydrants right on Main for the reason that mains too close might not be accessible in case of a serious, hot fire.

A main will also be laid on Hayter street before the street is paved in the 1947 street improvement project.

Residential water users outside of the city will now pay a monthly \$2 minimum, rather than the former \$1.25, McCleary announces.

The former rate was the same as that for taxpayers inside the city, and those inside the city also pay a 50-cent assessment to go to the construction of a sewage disposal plant. Thus, the non-city taxpaying group outside of the city were getting their water cheaper than the taxpayers in the city.

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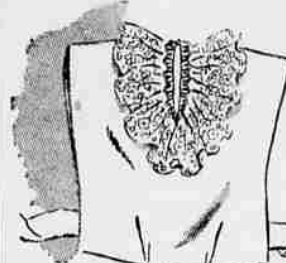
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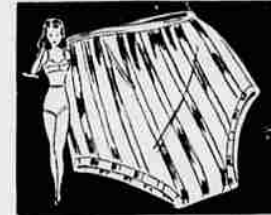
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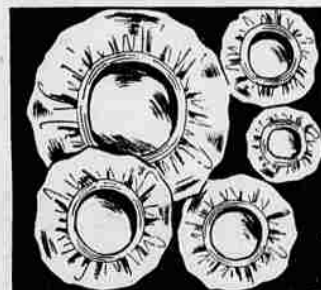
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
