

Stocks Advance To High Levels

New York, April 23 (AP)—The stock market rallied again today in some of the heaviest trading of the past two years.

Gains of fractions to more than two points were numerous as the highest average level since last July 25 was reached.

Selling of shares to cash in on recent price advances depressed both rails and oils at times. Some of the carriers came back to life in the final hour, however, and moderate improvement occurred elsewhere in the list.

Total sales for the entire session ran to around 2,300,000 shares.

Holding advances, such as new highs for the year or longer, were such issues as Union Pacific, Chesapeake & Ohio, Denver & Rio Grande, American Can, Dow Chemical, Owens Illinois, J. I. Case, Youngstown Sheet, International Paper and Shuey-Manville.
