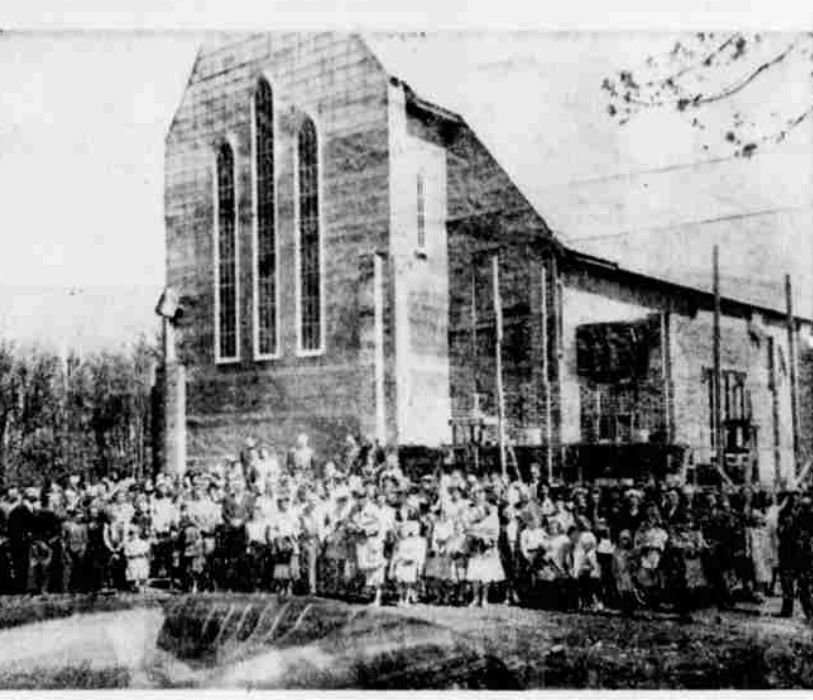

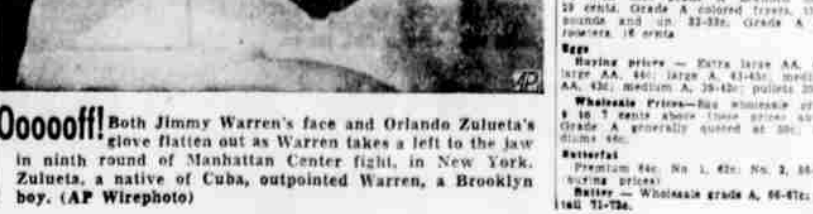
Wheat Sinks Following Gain
