Rural Sections Approve Budget

Albany, April 27—Voters of the Linn county rural school district have approved by a substantial margin the 1949-50 budget of \$976,622, it was determined after the ballots cast in the April 18 special election were canvassed at the courthouse.

The rural school district board members then voted to levy for \$705,172 above the tax base of \$271,450 to assure sufficient funds for the school year. The election was necessary as the district is otherwise limited to an increase of only 6 per cent above the tax base, according to County School Superintendent J. M. Bennett.

Approval for the additional levy resulted when the county showed 426 for and 305 against from 85 of the 90 polling districts. Three of the districts

unreported. Of those reported 31 were favorable and 29 against by slight margins.

The board voted that a budget of \$728,276.48 was needed for the elementary schools. They also decided that \$248,345.52 was needed for the high schools. The rural school district of Linn county covers all schools except Albany No. 5, Lebanon No. 16 and Sweet Home No. 55.
