He classed 23 as communist; seven as fascist; four as advo-cating force to deny constitu-tional rights to others; and two as seeking to change the form of government by "unconstitution-

The list was turned over to the loyalty board, which heads up the program of checking on the loyalty of government em-

Clark previously had furnish ed lists of about 100 organiza-

Active membership in the groups on the lists is grounds for dismissal of a government employe.
