Wheat Survey Ends May 1

W. M. Tate, chairman of the Marion County Agricultural Conservation Association, an-nounces that the wheat survey which was launched four week ago, is progressing steadily is expected that the field tact work will be completed by community committeemen May

Mr. Tate says that there are probably some wheat growers that the committeemen do not know about. It is desirable that all farms producing wheat in 1947, 1948 or 1949 be listed with the County Agricultural Conservation association. The results of the wheat acreage survey will be used to determine the producers' eligibility to vote in the event that Secretary of Agriculture Branan calls for a reference event that Secretary of Agricul-ture Brannan calls for a refer-endum on the 1950 wheat acre-age allotment proposal. The acreage shown by the survey will be the basis for both indi-vidual and county acreage allo-cations in the event that a wheat

acreage allotment program is proclaimed.

Mr. Tate urges all wheat growers who have not been contacted by community com-mitteemen to make a farm acre-age report immediately. This can be done by contacting a can be done by contacting a committeeman or by visiting the wheat office located adjacent to the 4-H club office in the old Salem high school building.




