

'Tag Day' for Band Tour Set

Solicitation, in the form of a "tag day" and other methods in the interest of providing funds with which to send approximately 100 boys and girls, comprising Salem high school's band and orchestra to the state tournament at Klamath Falls, opened Monday afternoon. The "tag day" sale will take place Saturday.

The "tag day" operation has been sanctioned by the Salem Retail Bureau. It is estimated that \$1500 will be needed to provide transportation, housing and meals. The group will make the trip in three buses, leaving Salem Thursday and returning the following Saturday.

The committee in charge of the campaign points out that while the band has been privileged to make a number of trips because of the demand for its services in parades, the orchestra has, for the most part, been tied down to the high school auditorium.

Since those engaged in the solicitation will not be able to reach everybody, those in charge of the movement suggest that persons wishing to contribute place checks in the mail addressed to "Band Trip Fund, Salem High School."

Polk Blood Quota Is Set by Center

Dallas—A quota of 400 pints of blood from Polk county has been set by the Portland center for the four remaining visits of the bloodmobile to the county during 1949.

Dates are June 15, August 16, October 26 and December 14.

One of the visits will be scheduled for Grand Ronde, and Merritt Hart, chairman of the county program, is planning another one of the four for either Monmouth or Independence. A third might be in Falls City. On the first visit to Dallas on April 6, 59 pints were taken.

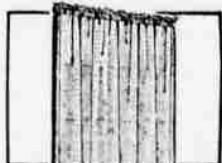

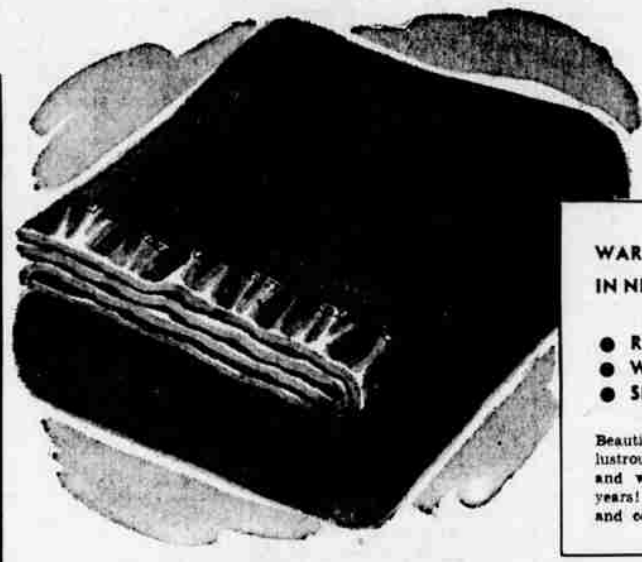
