### Rural School Zones Adjusted

Dallas — Zones of the Polk county rural school district have been adjusted by the district boundary board following the consolidation of the Monmouth, Independence, Parker and Valley View districts.

The consolidation formed a district of the first class and automatically removed it from the rural district.

Five zones comprise the rural school district and have been adjusted to include the following: Zone 1—Ballston (Polk county part), Salt Creek, Sheridan (Polk county part), Overhills, Bethel, Polk Station, Perrydale, Rickreall, Upper Salt Creek, Amity (Polk county part) and McCoy. Zone 2—Zena, Kola, Oak Grove, Brush College, Spring Valley, Popcorn, Lincoln, Greenwood, Hopewell (Polk county part) and Mountain View. Zone 3—Podes, Alzira, Ward (Polk county part), Wildwood, Burns Vista, Suver, Monticello Valley and Valsets.

Zone 4—Orchard View, Bridgeport, Antioch, Matieton, Oakdale, Guthrie, Black Rock, Liberty, Falls City and Oakhurst. Zone 5—Fern, Goosecreek, Gold Creek, Buell, Grand Ronde, Willamina (Polk county part) and Pioneer.

Three members of the rural school board will be elected on June 20 at the annual election. One each will be chosen from zones 2, 3 and 4.

Nominations are made by petition, signed by not less than 25 voters in the zone and presented to the county school superintendent 30 days prior to the election.
