### Prune Crop in Polk Promising

Dallas, May 26 — The best Italian prune crop in years is anticipated in Polk county, and an enormous yield is expected around Dallas, where dryer capacity will be taxed unless conditions are such in the harvest season to slow the picking.

The cherry crop will be only fair, according to growers. Blossom periods gave rise to optimistic outlooks, but in the face of this, the crop is light in some sections and spotted in distribution around the county. Some blame the heavy frosts which came after the blossom period.

Simon Grindheim, representative of a packing concern, states that the prune prospects are the best in this district in the past five seasons. He anticipates a 75 percent crop in Dallas area as compared with a half crop in 1947 and a smaller crop last year. In the Sheridan-Red Prairie district, a 70 percent crop is expected and in the West Salem district, 60 percent.

Frank Neufeld, who operates extensive orchards, states that valley orchards promise bumper crops, but hill orchards are somewhat poorer.

Total yield from Polk county, however, will not top peak years of the past because of the fact that many orchards have been grubbed out in the past four or five years.

Price outlook looks encouraging because of the fact that light crops in recent years were

cleaned up and the 1949 crop will go on the market without competition from holdover stock.

The Willamette Cherry Growers association has indicated that overall prospects for sweet cherries in the mid-valley district are for a much heavier crop than last year, although the crop appears spotty in Polk county.

Emergence of the cherry fruit fly has been noted and spray notices were sent out to growers at mid-week telling them to spray within the next ten days.
