

Dallas — Excavation on the new 3 million gallon water reservoir for Dallas is going forward rapidly with F. B. Miller and company, contractors, doing the work.

They had reached a depth of 12 feet this week for the 230 x 115 foot reservoir. An unexpected ledge of blue shale was struck in one half of the excavation, running diagonally across the area. The contracting company hoped that a strata of rock would not be encountered.

The ends and bisecting wall of the reservoir will drop 12 feet straight down, then taper inward diagonally until a total depth of 24 feet is reached.
