Miss Gregerson and Miss Olson left Portland Sunday by train. A stop has been arranged for the young women at Chicago, Washington, D. C., and Philadelphia. From New York will be four flights by plane. The two women are on separate planes, Miss Gregerson preceding Miss Olson by one day. They plan to return from Norway by boat.

Applications for the study in Oslo were made through the dean of the American division of the University of Oslo, Norman Nordstrand, a member of the faculty of St. Olaf's college of Northfield, Minn. Through the dean, all plans are completed for the entire travel and educational trip, including special excursions and sightseeing tours.
