"The evidence seems incontrovertible that the moon once had a good supply of air and water," Joquel said. "Some astronomers believe life could have existed there.

"It is not impossible that the beings who once lived on the moon discovered the secret of nuclear fission, just as we have done here on earth, used the power for a giant atomic war, and completely destroyed themselves and their world."

"This hypothesis not only re-conciles a number of conflicting theories about the moon," the society said, "but augments them by solving problems they left unanswered."

The moon's atmosphere might have been burned away in a chain reaction from the atomic

chain reaction from the atomic explosions, Joquel said. Or else the war was fought early in the moon's life, before the body's law gravity allowed the air to sexc.pe.

Some of the craters which make the face of the man in the moon might have been caused by atom bombs, he added. Some craters obviously were caused by volcanoes, he said, but the volcanoes might have been set off by the atomic explosions.
