William Frith, St. Paul, was third with 51.7 pounds for 20 cows. Other herds among the top six were: Harry Stewart, West Stayton, 51.7 pounds fat average for 5 cows and H. C. Stuwe, Woodburn. 51.4 pounds with 13 cows. Two herds tied for sixth place, Stephen Hemshors Ayrshire herd with 23 cows at Mt.
