Stocks Advance To Around Point

New York, June 23 (AP)—Timid buying was enough to boost the stock market today.

More business was done for a while when prices made their best showing but the day's sales were far from impressive.

Neither buying or selling interest ever became pronounced. Up most of the day, Motor, Chrysler, Studebaker, U. S. Rubber, Montgomery Ward, United Aircraft, American Smelting, American Can, Dow Chemical, Allied Chemical, Santa Fe, Southern Pacific, Sinclair Oil and Barnsdall Oil.

Hedging Causes Wheat to Drop

Chicago, June 23 (AP)—A little increase in hedging pressure served to send wheat lower on the board of trade today.

Corn and oats also sank, larger losses being recorded by the jury contracts. Deferred months lost only minor fractions. Soybeans and lard suffered fairly wide declines in line with another drop in cottonseed oil at New York.

Wheat closed 1 1/2-1 3/4 lower, July 1.97 1/2-3/4, corn was 1/4 lower, July 1.32 1/2-3/4, oats were 3/4 to 1 cent lower, July 59 1/2-3/4, rye was 1/2 to 2 cents lower, July 1.13 1/2-3/4, soybeans were 2 to 3 cents lower, July 23.21 1/2-3/4, and lard was 23 to 35 cents a hundred pounds lower, July 111.02.
