

## West Salem City Council Sets Merger Election Day

West Salem, July 7—July 26 was set Wednesday night by the city council as the date for a special election to vote upon merger with the city of Salem. The emergency ordinance adopted by the council provided for balloting between the hours of 8 a. m. and 8 p. m. Pacific standard time or 9 a. m. and 9 p. m. daylight saving time, with all voting to be at City hall. Appointed to serve on the election board were Mrs. Eunice Burk and Mrs. A. N. Copenhagen, judges; and Mrs. Hazel Newgent, Mrs. Mary Kuhn and Mrs. Wava McCormack, clerks.

Petitions requesting a merger election were presented to the council with 138 names with 61 of the names certified. Complete certification of the names by the county clerk was not necessary as the 61 names checked by the county clerk's office represented more than 5 per cent of the registered voters in West Salem.
