Grain Market About Steady

Chicago, Aug. 6 (AP) - The grain market drifted along with small price changes today. For the most part the trend was a little lower although a mild rally got underway shortly before the close and sent some contracts above the previous close. There was some profit-taking following yesterday's price run-up, particularly in May wheat. Cash wheat prices were slightly easier in the northwest and southwest.
Wheat closed 1/4 lower to 1/2 higher, September \$2.05 1/2-5/8, corn was 1/4-1/8 higher, September \$1.26 1/2-1/8, oats were 1/4 lower to 1/8 higher, September 66 1/2-3/4, rye was 1/4-1/8 higher, September \$1.52 1/4, soybeans were 1/2 to 1 1/2 higher, November \$2.37 1/2-1/8, and lard was 5 cents lower to 7 cents a hundred pounds higher, September \$12.85.

M. N. Crissell of Aurora Dies

Word has reached relatives here that M. N. Crissell, 75, retired farmer of Aurora, died August 5 while on a visit in Los Angeles. He had travelled south by plane July 24 to visit his son and brother, and Sunday, July 21, he suffered a stroke from which he did not regain consciousness.
Millard Newton Crissell was born July 18, 1874, near Stafford in Clackamas county and had lived all of his life on his farm located on the Willamette river five miles north of Aurora. On October 2, 1912, he was married to Florence Elizabeth Clark, who died January 13, 1939.
Crissell had been a member of Wilsonville L.O.O.F. for over 40 years. Active in community affairs until recent years, he had served for many years as a director of the old Union High school, later serving two terms as a director of Canby Union high school.
