

Polk Bridge Crew Worker Has Close Call With Death

Dallas, Aug. 11—Herschel Hanson, about 30, Dallas, was able to smile and state that he was "feeling fine" late Wednesday as he lay in his Bartell hospital bed after a narrow escape from electrocution. Hanson took a 11,000-volt shock about 1 p.m. Wednesday when a crane owned by Polk county contacted a high line of the Mountain States Power company about a mile east of Dallas.

Hanson, a member of the Polk county bridge construction crew, was following the crane as it was traveling slowly down a gravel road towards a site where the crew was building a bridge. He held a cable in one hand that was attached to the tip of the boom, suspended high in the air. As the crane passed under the 11,000-volt line the boom contacted the wires, and the current passed through his body.

Hanson was knocked unconscious and one hand and one leg were badly burned. He apparently owes his life to the fact that the gravel road was dry and the current, by passing through one side of his body, missed all vital organs.

The initial contact shorted out service in the district. Men of the power company disentangled the wires from the crane.

Two physicians were called to the scene to attend Hanson. A delay was incurred in bringing the injured man to the hospital since the Dallas ambulance was on another call to Salem.

Attendants state that they believe he will recover satisfactorily but must remain in the hospital for a few days.

Oregon Peach Crop Up Million Bushels

Portland, Aug. 11 (P)—Peach crops in Oregon and Washington are expected to total 5,807,000 bushels, a boost of about one million bushels over 1948.

The federal crop reporting service said the harvest may be 27 per cent above the 10-year average.

Pear harvest in the region was estimated at 12,838,000 boxes, above average and 2,500,000 boxes over last year's crop.
