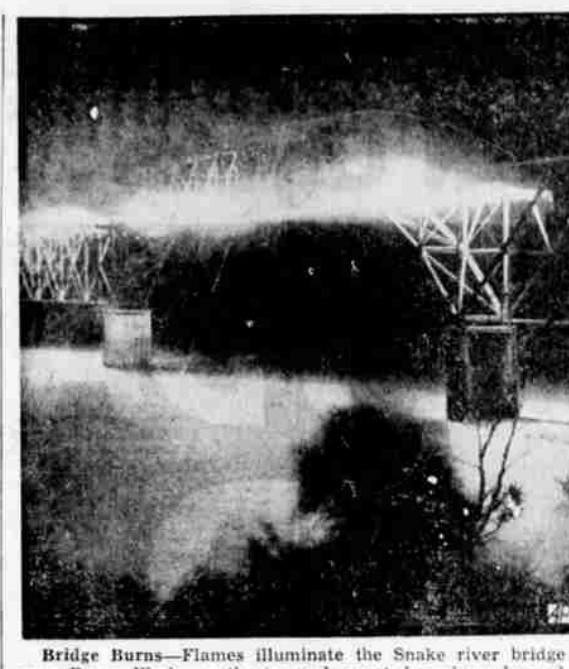

Advances were from fractions to more than a point among the leaders with only a handful lower in the major groups.
