### 'Ordinary' Dog Wins \$30,000 in Purses

 Denver—He's just an ordinary looking dog—even his owner says that.  
 But this is Beachcomber, the champion of all the dogs that have raced over greyhound tracks.

He has won more races than any dog that ever lived—79 victories since his first outing in a regular race in 1947. This is counting the first 28 days of the inaugural meeting at Denver's spanking new Mile High kennel club track.

Beachcomber almost didn't get to race at all. On March 10, 1947, a few hours before his first outing in a betting race, a fire swept the kennels in Florida. Six dogs perished, but nine others were saved. One was Beachcomber. That night he racked up victory No. 1.

In addition to his 79 wins, the champ has run second 34 times and third 18. In 184 races he
