Pearson Sues For \$1,200,000 New York, Dec. 17 (P)-Col-umnist Drew Pearson, who orig-inally sued Columnist Westbrook egler and others for \$500,000 in libel action, now is suing for \$1,200,000. Pearson obtained court per mission yesterday to increase the amount of the suit, after claim-ing that he and Pegler made an agreement in 1946 not to criti-

cize each other publicly. Pearson alleged Pegler violated the agreement in his col-umns of last May 23 June 8 and July 2. The libel action is based on statements made by Pegler in the three columns.

Pegler denies making any non-

criticism pact with Pearson. Pearson's amended action is seeking \$300,000 from King Features Syndicate and Pegler: \$200,000 from King Features alone; \$200,000 from Pelger alone, and \$500,000 from Hearst Consolidated Publications, Inc.
