The more conservative element began to leave. A few said good-by to the majority...

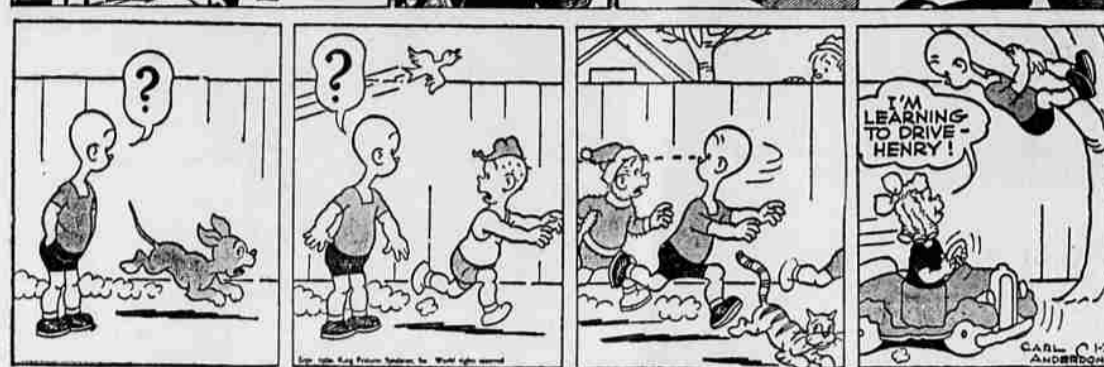
And so it came about that, while Officer Mullins exchanged views on wine and women with his fellow craftsmen...
