Grains Slump In Dull Trade
Chicago, Jan. 27 (AP)—Grains slumped toward the close on the board of trade today, winding up a dull day which saw few price changes.
During early dealings wheat showed a slight amount of strength while corn eased. But wheat also backed down late in the day. On both the upside and downside trading went on a slow pace.
Wheat closed 1/8-5/8 lower, March \$2.17 1/2, corn was 1/8-1/4 lower, March \$1.28 1/2, oats were unchanged to 1/4 lower, May 68 1/2, rye was 1/4-1/2 lower, May \$1.34 1/4-3/4, soybeans were 1/4 lower to 1/2 higher, March \$2.32-52.32 1/2, and lard was 3 cents lower to 3 cents a hundred pounds higher, March \$10.60.

Stocks Advance All Along Line
New York, Jan. 27 (AP)—Buying interest in steel shares helped to lift stock prices all along the line today.
The advance was slow in getting started and never did pick up much momentum. A good majority of leaders, though, showed gains running from fractions to a round point.
Activity increased moderately when a definite forward trend showed up. Turnover for the full session approached 1,300,000 shares.

Radio-Television issues enjoyed a flurry of popularity for a while and a couple of gold stocks did fairly well.
Bethlehem Steel led 1/2 point during the morning, despite the best earnings report for 1949 in the company's history. Later, however, the stock crossed to the plus side. U. S. Steel, Youngstown Sheet and Jones & Laughlin also improved.
