

Kentucky Town Without Water

Paintsville, Ky., Feb. 2 (AP)—Paintsville's 5000 residents had to haul in their drinking and cooking water today.

The town's water service was shut off late yesterday when supplies dropped to a critical level. The water plant had been flooded by the rising Big Sandy river.

Cyrus Cooper, water superintendent, attributed a sharp drainage of reserve supplies to a radio appeal to conserve water. Soon after the plea was broadcast, consumption was more than tripled by frantic users attempting to store up supplies.

The last 85,000 gallons in reserve tanks was saved for use in case of fire.
