Hollywood Hits Back at Charge Movies 'Depraving' U.S. Morals

Hollywood, March 16 (AP)—Movie bigwigs lashed back today at a senator's charges that Hollywood is "depraving" American morals.

The Motion Picture Association of America denounced demands by Sen. Edwin C. Johnson, D., Colo., for licensing controls on the industry as "a police state bill."

And the motion picture industry council called Johnson's attack "unreasonable."

"In the past, unfortunately, there have been congressmen and senators who have brought discredit and shame to the highest body of the government in the world," an MPIC statement said. "but it would be reckless to attack the congress for the actions of a few."
