New York, April 21 (UP)—It's downright flattering to be compared with Joe DiMaggio, agreed Booby Thomson of the Giants today, but he blurted, "It's also a lot of baloney."

For years the Giants have been insisting that in Thomson they have "the Joe DiMaggio of the National League." Occasionally, the good-looking, 27-year-old outfielder from Glasgow, Scotland, even has looked the part.

"Let's not kid ourselves," Thomson declared, "DiMaggio is the perfect player while I'm not even close."

"I still make a lot of mistakes and there are many things I have to learn. Maybe I should be satisfied with what I have done so far but I'm not. Far from it. I'm not easily satisfied."

Thomson batted .309 last season and was one of the few bright spots in an otherwise lusterless spring. He's had a miserable spring, however, a circumstance that doesn't bother him a bit.

"I've never been a world-beater in the spring," he shrugged. "It takes me a little while to get untracked. I know that I'm in good shape and that I'll come around soon."
