

Wise Packers Outfox, Weather

Every year you and I have the same lament:

"Why didn't we make better use of the clothes we took along on our vacation trip? Why didn't we take other things that might have served us better?"

Do we profit by this experience? Not usually.

Somehow you always expect vacation lands to be warm and sunny. The very thought of taking an umbrella would dampen your spirits. Yet warm clothes and rainwear are just as essential to a vacation in the mountains, at the shore or on a motor trip as they are to daily living at home.

So, even if it is a sweltering sunny day when you leave, pack a warm cardigan sweater, warm nightgown, raincoat and light overshoes for every member of the family. Throw an umbrella in the back of the car, just in case.

You should take one suit for chilly days besides the lightweight frocks of easily laundered nylon, seersucker and cotton, and one pair of dark shoes. There is nothing sillier than white shoes on a rainy day—even at a vacation spot.

Unless you are going to a very swank resort, one evening skirt and two evening blouses should suffice for dress-up evenings.

And, you don't need to pack your jewel cases—a string of pearls, pearl earrings and one simple pin that can be attached to evening dress, sweater, blouse or even night robe, will be sufficient accent when necessary.

Of course you'll take a bathing suit, sun glasses, sunburn creams. Add to that shampoo, always handy for hurry-up hair laundering, bobby pins, polish remover, nail polish, cleansing tissues, comb and brush.

Bring a warm beach jacket or robe if you vacation at the shore.

Sometimes this can double as emergency bathrobe and possibly even as a wrap for chilly evenings. You'll need a fairly warm wool coat or jacket for mountain vacations, and a good pair of walking shoes.

If you pack wisely, you can pack at a minimum. If you've been to a resort before you should know whether shorts or slacks will serve you better. In any case for a two-weeks vacation, besides your lightweight dresses, you'll need several pair of shorts, a few blouses or sweaters and at least one pair of slacks—for chilly days or nights, playtime or hiking.

Study Abroad Makes World A Classroom

NAMES on the map of the world are going to become real places for thousands of teachers and students planning to study abroad.

Increasing numbers of teachers and students will be flocking to the United States as well. For these education-seekers, the governments of the world have provided thousands of scholarships.

The United Nations Educational Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) has issued a new edition of its international handbook, "Study Abroad."

More than 21,000 opportunities for foreign study, observation and research are listed. Distributed by Columbia University Press, it is the only single volume offering detailed information of this kind gathered on a worldwide scale. The emphasis is on fellowships, scholarships and educational grants that will promote closer relationships between citizens of certain regions; improve international understanding; and facilitate the exchange of ideas. The grants are classified according to the country of origin and show more than 5,000 such awards stemming from private and governmental sources in the United States. Fifty-two other nations and 23 territories are also represented.

Other useful sources to consult, if you are planning to study abroad are: "Work, Study, Travel Abroad," published by the U. S. National Student Association; "To Study Abroad," by the Educational Travel Division of the American Express Company; Travel Service of the National Education Association; the Student's International Travel Association (SITA); and American Youth Hostels (AYH).

All of these deal with summer opportunities and include work camps, study programs, seminars and summer study-travel programs, country by country.

Also, though there will be student travel by boat as in previous years, many more students will go by air, with universities and private agencies planning such trips as part of their summer school programs.
