

War Bride Says Commies Must Have Tortured Husband

Nashville, Ill., July 13 (AP)—A pretty war bride said today that the North Koreans must have applied "cruel oriental tortures" to force her husband, Capt. Ambrose H. Nugent, to broadcast propaganda for them.

"They must have tortured him terribly," said Mrs. Nugent, the former Olga Margaret Koenig of Amberg, Bavaria.

"Otherwise I know he would never do anything to hurt his country, he is too patriotic, too loyal for that."

A man claiming to be Nugent was heard by U. S. monitors, broadcasting over the communist radio at Seoul.

Speaking in a "tired, halting, toneless voice," he urged American troops to desert and to oppose the "capitalist monopolists of the United States" in their "barbarous aggressive action" in Korea.

Nugent is a member of the 52nd artillery battalion attached to the 24th Infantry Division. Elements of his battalion were included in a group cut off by the North Koreans last week. However, the army did not confirm that Nugent had been captured. It merely acknowledged that its records included that of Nugent and listed his home as South Center avenue in Merrill, Wis.

Mrs. Nugent has lived here since her husband was recruiting officer for the southern Illinois district after the war. His three children by a previous marriage are with her.

"I'm not convinced that my husband actually has been captured," she said. "I plan to ask the Red Cross today for confirmation."

"It's true that my husband has a baritone voice. But if he actually did broadcast for them, they must have hurt him terribly."
