McCarthy Again On Warpath

Washington, July 13 (AP)—Senator McCarthy Wednesday sent to President Truman signed statements which he said prove that state department personnel files were deliberately stripped of derogatory data in 1946.

McCarthy, Wisconsin republican, told a news conference the statements were signed by one present employee of the state department and three former employees. One of the former employees, McCarthy added, now is an FBI agent.

McCarthy produced photographic copies of the statements which he sent to the White House.

The Wisconsin lawmaker also produced a copy of a letter from FBI Chief J. Edgar Hoover. McCarthy said this letter proves Senator Tydings, D-Md., did not tell the truth when he said June 21 that an FBI study of 81 state department loyalty files disclosed nothing to sustain charges by McCarthy that the records had been tampered with and "denuded."

Tydings is chairman of a senate foreign relations subcommittee which has been investigating McCarthy's contentions that the state department harbors communists and red sympathizers.

Tydings said last month that the information about an FBI examination of the loyalty files came to him from Peyton Ford, an assistant to the attorney general.

State Electrical Code 'Unconstitutional'

Grants Pass, Ore., July 13 (AP)—Circuit Judge O. J. Millard ruled Wednesday that the Oregon electrical code was unconstitutional.

He termed that the Oregon legislature's adoption of the national electric code, which sets minimum standards for electrical wiring, was an "unconstitutional delegation of authority."

The ruling was handed down in the cases of Eugene R. Brown v. Samuel J. Miller, electrical contractor at Cave Junction,
