

Bearcat Grid Training To Start September 4th

A half hundred young men, 21 of them freshmen and consequently new to the campus, will report to Coach Chester Stackhouse the morning of September 4 for training in connection with the Bearcat's 1950 football campaign.

The morning will be devoted to distribution of equipment and the afternoon to the first workout. Since a number of the candidates will work at the state fairgrounds in various capacities during the week, practice sessions will be interrupted to some extent until the following week. However, since the first game is not slated until Sept. 23, the hit and miss schedule for the first week will not interfere too much.

Of the squad of 50 who will report, 16 of them are lettermen, including Chuck Bowe and Bill Ewaliko, who captained the two teams that took part in the intra-squad game of last spring.

Insofar as Coach Stackhouse has learned only one prospective candidate for the squad has been called by the armed forces. However, there is a possibility that Bill Ewaliko, 220 pound tackle, may be in uniform before the football season gets under way.

The new McCulloch stadium, now in course of construction will be used this fall. This structure built at a cost in excess of \$130,000, will seat approximately 3750 persons and will be one of the finest in the state.

The schedule calls for 10 games, five of them to be played on McCulloch field. The field will be dedicated October 14 when the University of Hawaii makes its first appearance in Salem. Other home games in addition to the opener with Central Washington college, include: College of Idaho, Sept. 30, Whitworth college, Oct. 7 and Linfield, Nov. 4.

Rooms for some 15 young men who will play football under Coach Chester Stackhouse will be needed early next week. The rooms are wanted on an exchange basis — the occupant doing some work for the accommodations offered. It also means that 15 young fellows will have their educational program advanced considerably by virtue of not having to pay cash money for their rooms.

Spoke Fielder Likely to Claim Second WI Hit Crown

Tacoma, Aug. 29 (AP)—Glenn (Jeep) Stetter, stocky Spokane outfielder seems destined to become the first Western International league batsman to wear the loop hitting crown twice.

With only two weeks remaining in the season, the Indians' outfielder held a 14-point bulge over his nearest competitor, figures released today by the league office here disclosed. Stetter won his first title back in 1948 when he clubbed the ball at a .366 clip for Wenatchee, and this season he is bettering that mark, checking in with .371 through games of Sunday, August 27.

Dick Greco, the Tacoma bridge-room, continued in the runner-up slot with .357, one point off his pace of last week, while Bill McCawley, Yakima outfielder, trailed in third place with .343.

Greco, however, continued his mastery in the two other important divisions of the hit case. His home-run production was upped by one to 31 for the top

mark while Gene Thompson, Victoria outfielder, was next with 23.

The big Tacoma right fielder also stretched his lead in the runs batted in department, knocking seven mates across the plate during the week to raise his total to 138 for the season. Jim Warner of Tri-City was second with 112, while Jim Westlake, Yakima third baseman, was third with 111.

'Weekend Player' Defeats Aussie Star in Nationals

Forest Hills, N. Y., Aug. 29 (AP) Don McNeill, who at 32 likes to call himself a "weekend" tennis player, may be just that.

But don't try to tell young Ken McGregor, the Australian Davis cup team's boy wonder. Ken occupied a spot in the stands today, along with some 50 other also rans. Meanwhile, McNeill, the 1940 national champion who hasn't even entered the tourney since 1948, took on Bill Talbert.

McNeill's stunning 9-7, 3-6, 6-4, 6-1 triumph over McGregor in the first round of the national singles championships yesterday proved that you've got to have more than a mighty service to get by the court-wise veterans.

"As a matter of fact," said McNeill, "McGregor did not seem to be quite as good as he is cracked up to be. After all, I'm an old gaffer, and he certainly could outrun me. But I had my strategy planned and had to sink or swim with it."

"I rushed him all the way and was able to pass him at the net."

My ground strokes were just good enough to keep him hopping. Of course, he probably was tired after that long match with Tom Brown Sunday. But he still will have to improve his ground strokes considerably before he becomes a real champion."
